**Volunteers and Host Project will be contacted regularly to know how they are facing their project, whether everything is going on well or they are having problems. This will form as a basis of monitoring both the volunteer and the project.**



**The volunteer will be assessed based on his/her contribution to the orphanage. He/she will be allowed to give a written evaluation about the project and volunteering in the project.**

**Support to the volunteer:**

**-by, during and after the EVS activities, in particular in crisis prevention and management  
-for insurance, visa, residence permit, travel arrangement and all the EVS administrative procedures:**

**-by facilitating the volunteer's participation in the EVS training cycle (pre-departure training, mid term and final evaluation):**

**-by foreseeing proper evaluation measures;**

**-by encouraging a follow-up activity: every volunteer has the right to plan and implement a follow up activity.**

**Information:**

**An EVS partner have the right to receive complete information on the activity and agree on all aspects.**

**Each EVS volunteer is entitled to receive a Youthpass.**

- 2. The volunteers will assist the Teachers in the classroom, Teach the children Basic Education, Drawing etc**
- 3. a)To tourist centres( Excursions) – Occasional.**  
**b) Organising fund raising for the orphans – Occasional**

**General risk prevention:**

#### **PREVENTION OF HEALTH PROBLEMS:**

**Volunteers are advised to vaccinate themselves before entering Ghana, and also upon their arrival they will be educated of the preventious methods to stay away from some health problems.**

#### **SAFETY MEASURES:**

**Volunteers will be oriented on some safety precautions they must always take, and to stay away from trouble and problems.**

#### **CODE OF CONDUCT:**

**Rules and regulation will be made available to all volunteers to obey, and punishments will be given to those volunteers who flaut those rules and regulations.**

#### **SUPPORT:**

**A contact person will be assigned to the volunteers, this person will help them with their activities and also deal with any other issue which they cannot deal on their own.**

#### **COUNSELLING:**

**Orientation will be provided to the volunteers upon their arrival in order to educate them on the national issues and how to cohabitate with the local inhabitants.**
